On August 15, 2026, the Embassy of India in Malabo celebrated the 80th Independence Day of India at the chancery premises with immense patriotism and solemn pride.

The event commenced with the singing of Vande Mataram, the national song of India, and followed by the hoisting of the National Flag by Ambassador Prashant Kumar Das and singing of the National Anthem.
